Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Hevesi, S.3436, and Assembly Member M. Cohen, A.7188, "AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to civil liability of vehicle owners for maximum speed limit violations and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof": and
