Whereas, a bill has been introduced in the New York State Legislature by; Assembly Members Dinowitz and Abbate, et al, A.1115, "AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York and the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to allowing citizens to issue tickets to designated officers and appointed employees of the parking violations bureau" and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it
