WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on February 9, 2001 a copy of its designation dated January 30, 2001 (the "Designation"), of the August and Augusta Schoverling House located at 344 Westervelt Avenue, Borough of Staten Island, as a landmark and Block 38/Lot 35, as its landmark site, pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on April 4, 2001, its report on the Designation dated March 28, 2001 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on April 18, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

Pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter, and on the basis of the information and materials contained in the Designation and the Report, the Council affirms the Designation.
