Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Marchi, S.5096, and by Committee on Rules, A.8483, "AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to establishing a variable supplements fund for members of the New York city employees' retirement system"; and
