**Title:** Resolution calling upon the New York State Legislature to amend the Election Law to clarify and codify the State's long-standing practice of placing voting machines in certain nursing homes, residential health care facilities and other similar residences where disabled and elderly voters live, many of whom are unable to travel to poll sites without great difficulty and further calling upon the United States Department of Justice to deny pre-clearance and/or otherwise prohibit the removal of the voting machines from these residential health care facilities.
