A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the changing of the names of designated landmarks.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Title 25 of the Administrative Code of the city of New York is hereby amended by adding a new section 25-102.2 to read as follows:

§ 25-102.2. **Designated landmark names.** The name of any entity designated as a landmark, pursuant to the provisions of section 25-303 of the administrative code, shall not be changed by local law.
