A Local Law in relation to a street name, Jonathan Nigro Place, Borough of Brooklyn.

*Be it enacted by the Council as follows:*

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New Name	Present Name	Limits
Jonathan Nigro Place	West 2 <sup>nd</sup> Street	from Avenue P to Quentin Road
