## By Council Members Felder and Perkins

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to removing the prohibition on sidewalk obstructions on certain streets in Brooklyn.

## Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section one. Paragraph four of subdivision c of section 19-136 of the administrative code of the city of New York, as last

amended by local law 104 of 1993, is amended by amending subdivision a and adding new subdivisions f, g, h and i to read as

follows:

19-136. c. 4. On the following streets where general vending has been prohibited by the street vendor review panel pursuant

to section 20-465.1 of this code and any rules promulgated thereunder, the provisions of paragraph one of this subdivision shall not

apply:

- (a) Thirteenth avenue between  $39^{\text{th}}$  street and  $[44^{\text{th}}] \underline{55}^{\text{th}}$  street in the borough of Brooklyn;
- (b) Newkirk Plaza between Foster avenue and Newkirk avenue in the borough of Brooklyn;
- (c) Eighty-sixth street between Bay Parkway and 23<sup>rd</sup> avenue in the borough of Brooklyn;
- (d) West 4<sup>th</sup> street between Sixth avenue and Seventh avenue in the borough of Manhattan;
- (e) Delancey street between Orchard street and Essex street in the borough of Manhattan;

- (f) <u>Sixteenth avenue between 38<sup>th</sup> street and 60<sup>th</sup> street in the borough of Brooklyn;</u>
- (g) Eighteenth avenue between Ocean Parkway and 60<sup>th</sup> street in the borough of Brooklyn;
- (h) <u>Avenue J between Coney Island avenue and East 16<sup>th</sup> street in the borough of Brooklyn;</u>
- (i) <u>Coney Island avenue between Avenues I and P in the borough of Brooklyn.</u>
- §2. This local law shall take effect immediately after it is enacted into law.
