Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senators Lachman, Kruger, Markowitz, Mendez, Onorato and Sampson, S.1406, and Assembly Member Hikind, et al, A.7603, "AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to temporarily suspending property owner's duty to remove snow, ice and dirt from sidewalks during certain times"; and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it
