WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on January 22, 2002 a copy of its designation dated January 8, 2002 (the "Designation"), of the Begrisch Hall at Bronx Community College, City University of New York, located at 2050 Sedgwick Avenue, University Heights (Block 3222/part of Lot 62), Borough of the Bronx as a landmark and Block 3222/part of Lot 62 as its landmark site, pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on March 7, 2002 its report on the Designation dated March 6, 2002 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on April 2, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;
