Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Velella, S.6760, and Assembly Members Abbate, Seddio, Cymbrowitz and Lavelle, et al, A.10470, "AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to the application of the age fifty-seven retirement program, the mandated physically taxing program and the incumbent fifty-five/twenty-five program for certain employees"; and
