**Title:** Resolution calling for the appointment of a special federal prosecutor to investigate alleged human rights violations, wrongful removals, and unconstitutional practices against children and their families by the New York City Administration for Children's Services and its contracted agencies, and to investigate the New York Family Court System for violation of the United States Court of Appeals ruling that "it is unconstitutional for the Administration for Children's Services to remove children from their parents' custody without a court order unless there is an imminent risk of harm."
