Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senators Padavan, Maltese, Marchi and Velella, S.6313, and Assembly Members Abbate, Colton, Cymbrowitz, Lavelle, Pheffer, Seddio and Weisenberg, et al, A.9915, "AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to the employment of retired New York city police personnel"; and
