Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senators Maltese, Balboni, Hannon, Johnson, Lavallo, Leibell, Marcellino, Marchi, Morahan, Padavan, Spano, Trunzo and Velella, S.6473-B, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.10407-B, "AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York and the retirement and social security law, in relation to the determination of retirement benefits of certain members of the New York city police pension fund, subchapter two and the New York city department pension fund, subchapter two"; and
