WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on June 28, 2002 a copy of its designation dated June 18, 2002 (the "Designation"), of the Plant and Scrymser Pavilions for Private Patients, St. Luke's Hospital (now St. Luke's-Roosevelt Hospital Center), located at 401 West 113th Street and 400 West 114th Street (a.k.a. 30-34 Morningside Drive), Borough of Manhattan, as a landmark and Block 1866, Lot 1 in part, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on August 14, 2002 its report on the Designation dated August 7, 2002 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on September 5, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

RESOLVED:

Pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter, and on the basis of the information and materials contained in the Designation and the Report, the Council affirms the Designation.
