WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on July 3, 2002 a copy of its designation dated June 25, 2002 (the "Designation"), of Public School 116 (The Elizabeth Farrell School), located at 515 Knickerbocker Avenue, a/k/a 495-517 Knickerbocker Avenue, 273-281 Grove Street and 222-230 Menahan Street, Borough of Brooklyn as a landmark and (Block 3317/Lot 1) as its landmark site, pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on August 28, 2002 its report on the Designation dated August 21, 2002 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on October 1, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;
