Resolution approving an Urban Development Action Area Project located at 261-67 Hart Street, a.k.a.128 Sumner Avenue and 128 Marcus Garvey Boulevard (Block 1769/Lot 50), 561 Jefferson Street (Block 1649/Lot 51), 742 Hancock Street (Block 1663/Lot 18), 823R Kent Avenue (Block 1898/Lot 23), 825 Kent Avenue (Block 1898/Lot 22), and 1034 Greene Avenue (Block 1623/Lot 24), Brooklyn, and waiving the urban development action area designation requirement and the Uniform Land Use Review Procedure, pursuant to Sections 693 and 694 of the General Municipal Law (L.U. WHEREAS, the New York City Department of Housing Preservation and Development ("HPD") submitted to the Council on May 16, 2002, its request dated May 6, 2002 that the Council take the following actions regarding the following Urban Development Action Area Project (the "Project") located at 261-67 Hart Street a.k.a.128 Sumner Avenue and 128 Marcus Garvey Boulevard (Block 1769/Lot 50), 561 Jefferson Street (Block 1649/Lot 51), 742 Hancock Street (Block 1663/Lot 18), 823R Kent Avenue (Block 1898/Lot 23), 825 Kent Avenue (Block 1898/Lot 22), and 1034 Greene Avenue (Block 1623/Lot 24), Borough of Brooklyn (the "Disposition Area"):

- 1. Find that the present status of the Disposition Area tends to impair or arrest the sound growth and development of the municipality and that the proposed Urban Development Action Area Project is consistent with the policy and purposes stated in Section 691 of the General Municipal Law;
 - 2. Waive the area designation requirement of Section 693 of the General Municipal Law pursuant to said Section;
- 3. Waive the requirements of Sections 197-c and 197-d of the New York City Charter pursuant to Section 694 of the General Municipal Law;

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and	4.	Approve the Project as an Urban Development Action Area Project pursuant to Section 694 of the General Municipal Law;
