Resolution calling upon the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, the Empire State Development Corporation, the Governor of the State of New York, the New York City Economic Development Corporation and the Mayor of the City of New York to modify the World Trade Center Disaster Action Plan for Businesses and the Guidelines for the Small Firm Attraction and Retention Grant Program (the "SFARG Program"), so that any business that was operating from business premises located south of Canal Street as of September 11, 2001, and which presently holds a lease to an existing premises there, may qualify for a grant under the Small Firm Attraction

and Retention Program.
