WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission filed with the Council on January 10, 2003 its decision dated January 8, 2003 (the "Decision") on the application submitted pursuant to Section 197-c of the New York City Charter by the Department of Citywide Administrative Services, for the disposition of two (2) city-owned properties pursuant to zoning located at 155 Skillman Street (Block 1914/Lot 11) and 1202 Fulton Street (Block 1860/Lot 16), Community District 3, Borough of Brooklyn (ULURP No. C 020646 PPK) (the "Application");
