Resolution affirming the designation by the Landmarks Preservation Commission of the (Former) Childs' Restaurant Building located at 2102 Boardwalk, Brooklyn, Designation List No. 344, LP-2106 (L.U. No. 420; 20035183 HKK; N 030332 HKK).

WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on February 11, 2003 a copy of its designation dated February 4, 2003 (the "Designation"), of the (Former) Childs' Restaurant Building located at 2102 Boardwalk (a.k.a. 3052-3078 West 21st Street), Community District 13, Borough of Brooklyn, as a landmark and Block 7071, Lot 130, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on April 4, 2003, its report on the Designation dated April 2, 2003 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on April 28, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

RESOLVED:

Pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter, and on the basis of the information and materials contained in the Designation and the Report, the Council affirms the Designation.
