WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on May 7, 2003 its approval of the petition of Leshko Coffee Shop, Inc., for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 111 Avenue A, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
