WHEREAS, the New York City Health and Hospitals Corporation, filed with the Council on July 18, 2003 notice of the Board of Directors authorization of the leasing to the Albert Einstein College of Medicine of Yeshiva University of two (2) parcels of land and buildings located on the Jacobi Medical Center campus, upon terms and conditions set forth in the Health and Hospitals Corporation resolution authorizing the lease, a copy of which is attached hereto (the "Lease");
