Resolution affirming the designation by the Landmarks Preservation Commission of Erasmus Hall High School located at 899-925 Flatbush Avenue, Brooklyn, Designation List No. 348, LP-2130 (L.U. No. 535; 20045005 HKK; N 040008 HKK).

WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on July 3, 2003 a copy of its designation dated June 24, 2003 (the "Designation"), of Erasmus Hall High School located at 899-925 Flatbush Avenue (a/k/a 2212-2240 Bedford Avenue), Community District 14, Borough of Brooklyn, as a landmark and Block 5130, Lot 10, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on August 29, 2003, its report on the Designation dated August 27, 2003 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on September 23, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

RESOLVED:

Pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter, and on the basis of the information and materials contained in the Designation and the Report, the Council affirms the Designation.
