WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission filed with the Council on October 6, 2003 its decision dated September 24, 2003 (the "Decision") on the application submitted pursuant to Section 197-c of the New York City Charter by the Department of Citywide Administrative Services, for the disposition to the Economic Development Corporation of one city-owned property pursuant to zoning, located in a portion of the former bed of Scholes Street at English Kills (Block 2962/Lot 999), Community District 1, Borough of Brooklyn (ULURP No. C 030313 PPK) (the "Application");

WHEREAS, the Decision is subject to review and action by the Council pursuant to Section 197-d(b)(3) of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Decision and Application on November 17, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Decision and Application;
