Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senators Stavisky, Brown, Lachman, Onorato, Sampson and Smith, S.2126, and Assembly Members Cohen, Markey, Seddio, Cook and Pheffer, et al, A.772, "AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to civil liability of vehicle owners for maximum speed limit violations and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof"; and
