Whereas, a bill has been introduced in the New York State Legislature by; Assembly Members Ortiz and Rivera, et al, A.5683, "AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to prohibiting the display of pornographic magazines or materials by street vendors in cities of one million or more"; and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it
