**Title:** Resolution calling upon the Council of the City of New York to call on the Federal Aviation

Administration to freeze the development of the Westchester County Airport at its current capacity and weight limitation of planes and site footprint, and that such freeze on development should also include a limitation on the number of flights, hangars, gates and number of parking spaces at current levels in order that we may protect our fragile environment from the noise, air and water pollution that any such expansion would generate, and that the Clerk of the Council of the City of New York shall herewith forward the text of this resolution to the Federal Aviation Administration and New York City's Federal and State delegation and stakeholders and all other pertinent parties so that the intent of the Council

of the City of New York may be widely known.
