Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Maltese, S.6223, and Assembly Member Colton, A.9810, "AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York and the retirement and social security law, in relation to including a twenty-five year retirement program for members of the New York city employees' retirement system
