Resolution affirming the designation by the Landmarks Preservation Commission of the Williamsburg Houses located at 142-190 Leonard Street (a.k.a. 86-120 Maujer Street), Brooklyn, Designation List No. 348, LP-2135-A (L.U. No. 113; 20045383 HKK; N 040311 HKK).

WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on February 19, 2004 a copy of its amended designation dated February 10, 2004 (the "Designation"), of the Williamsburg Houses located at 142-190 Leonard Street (a.k.a. 86-120 Maujer Street), Borough of Brooklyn, as a landmark and Block 3024, Lot 1, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on April 2, 2004, its report on the Designation dated March 24, 2004 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on April 19, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

RESOLVED:

Pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter, and on the basis of the information and materials contained in the Designation and the Report, the Council affirms the Designation.
