Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senators Padavan, Maltese, Marchi and Mendez, S.1475, and Assembly Members Abbate, Colton, Cymbrowitz, Pheffer, Seddio, Weisenberg, et al, A.3156, "AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to the employment of retired New York city police personnel"; and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it
