A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York in relation to the imposition of fees by the Landmarks Preservation Commission.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Section 25-304 of the administrative code of the City of New York is hereby amended by adding a new subdivision c to read as follows:

c. In the event that the commission shall establish or impose a fee, whether by rule or otherwise, in connection with the granting or consideration of an application for a certificate of no effect pursuant to section 25-306 or an application for a certificate of appropriateness pursuant to sections 25-307, 25-308 or 25-309,

such fee shall not exceed five hundred (\$500.00) dollars.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
