A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to prohibiting food vendors from vending over any ventilation grill, cellar door, manhole, transformer vault, or subway access grating.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Section 17-315 of Subchapter 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 17 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding a new subdivision m to read as follows:

m. No food vendor shall vend over any ventilation grill, cellar door, manhole, transformer vault, or subway access grating.

§2. This local law shall take effect 90 days after its enactment.
