WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on October 20, 2004 its approval of the petition of 57 Restaurant Associates, LLC, d/b/a Rue 57, for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed small sidewalk café located at 60 West 57th Street, Community District 5, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
