**Title:** Resolution urging the United States Congress to pass the Count Every Vote Act of 2005, introduced in the Senate by Senator Hillary Rodham Clinton and in the House by Representative Stephanie Tubbs Jones, a comprehensive package of pro-democracy, pro-voter legislation that contains the Civic Participation Act of 2005, a measure to restore voting rights in Federal elections to ex-offenders who have completed their sentences.
