Whereas a bill has been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Sampson S.2158, "An ACT authorizing the city of New York to reconvey its interest in certain real property acquired by in rem tax foreclosure in the borough of Brooklyn to former owner Elva McZeal Tenants Association Development Fund Corporation, notwithstanding expiration of the two year period within which application may be made to the city to release its interest in property thus acquired; Block No. 3785 Lot No.1 and No. 75 on the tax map of the borough of Brooklyn"; and
