State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass a bill introduced by Senator Maltese S.3632 and Assembly Member Abbate A.6718, "AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law and the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to accident disability retirements of uniformed New York city police and fire members."

Whereas a bill has been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Maltese S.3632 and Assembly Member Abbate A.6718, AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law and the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to accident disability retirements of uniformed New York city police and fire members;" and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore be it

Resolved, that the Council of the City of New York, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of the Article 9 of the Constitution of the State of New York, does hereby request the New York State Legislature to enact into law the aforesaid pending bill.
