State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Padavan, S.3428, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.6943-A, "AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to additional member contributions by employees of the department of sanitation in cities having a population of one million or more".

Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Padavan, S.3428, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.6943-A, "AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to additional member contributions by employees of the department of sanitation in cities having a population of one million or more"; and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the Council of the City of New York, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of Article 9 of the Constitution of the State of New York, does hereby request the New York State Legislature to enact into law the aforesaid pending bills.
