Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Golden, S.4447, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.7232, "AN ACT to amend the education law, the retirement and social security law and the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to permitting members of the New York state and New York city teachers' retirement systems to claim retirement credit for certain service in the New York state job corps training program"; and
