WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on March 22, 2005, copy of its designation dated March 15, 2005 (the "Designation"), of the A.I. Namm & Son Department Store, located at 450-458 Fulton Street (a.k.a. 1-7 Hoyt Street), Community District 2, Borough of Brooklyn, as a landmark and Block 157, Lot 9, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on May 2, 2005 its report on the Designation dated April 27, 2005 (the "Report");
