Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Padavan, S.3972, and Assembly Members Abbate, Colton, Cymbrowitz, Pheffer, Seddio and Weisenberg, A.6381, "AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to the employment of retired New York city police personnel"; and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it
