**RESOLVED**, That the Council of the City of New York hereby approves the proposed reallocation of Thirty First Year Community Development Funds as submitted by the Mayor on May 5, 2005, in accordance with the schedule of changes contained in the attached committee report; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, That the Council of the City of New York hereby will have the opportunity to review the allocation as part of the Fiscal Year 2006 budget adoption, of that portion of the Thirty Second Year Community Development Budget (one-half of the anticipated entitlement grant amount, as well as the remainder of all other sources) that will be scheduled to be spent in Fiscal Year 2007 and not Fiscal Year 2006.
