# THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK RESOLUTION NO. 1143

Resolution approving an Urban Development Action Area Project located at 82 Rogers Avenue (Block 1232/Lot 26), 367 Sterling Place (Block 1166/Lot 96), 455 Eastern Parkway (Block 1261/Lot 64), 658 Dean Street (block 1137/Lot 45), 818 St. Johns Place (Block 1254/Lot 31), 930 Pacific Street (Block 1132/Lot 25), 1271 St. Marks Avenue (Block 1356/Lot 70), 1687 Dean Street (Block 1342/Lot 71), and 1689 Dean Street (Block 1342/Lot 71), Brooklyn, and waiving the urban development action area designation requirement and the Uniform Land Use Review Procedure, pursuant to Sections 693 and 694 of the General Municipal Law (L.U. No. 488; 20055592 HAK).

#### **By Council Members Katz and Martinez**

WHEREAS, the New York City Department of Housing Preservation and Development ("HPD") submitted to the Council on May 10, 2005, its request dated April 25, 2005 that the Council take the following actions regarding the following Urban Development Action Area Project (the "Project") located at 82 Rogers Avenue (Block 1232/Lot 26), 367 Sterling Place (Block 1166/Lot 96), 455 Eastern Parkway (Block 1261/Lot 64), 658 Dean Street (Block 1137/Lot 45), 818 St. Johns Place (Block 1254/Lot 31), 930 Pacific Street (Block 1132/Lot 25), 1271 St. Marks Avenue (Block 1356/Lot 70), 1687 Dean Street (Block 1342/Lot 71), and 1689 Dean Street (Block 1342/Lot 71), Community District 8, Borough of Brooklyn (the "Project Area"):

- 1. Find that the present status of the Project Area tends to impair or arrest the sound growth and development of the municipality and that the proposed Urban Development Action Area Project is consistent with the policy and purposes stated in Section 691 of the General Municipal Law;
- 2. Waive the area designation requirement of Section 693 of the General Municipal Law pursuant to said Section;
  - 3. Waive the requirements of Sections 197-c and 197-d of the New York City Charter pursuant to Section 694 of the General Municipal Law;

- 4. Approve the Project as an Urban Development Action Area Project pursuant to Section 694 of the General Municipal Law; and
- 5. Approve the exemption of the Project from real property taxes pursuant to Section 696 of the General Municipal Law (the "Tax Exemption").

WHEREAS, the Project is to be developed on land that is now an eligible area as defined in Section 692 of the General Municipal Law, consists solely of the rehabilitation or conservation of existing private or multiple dwellings or the construction of one to four unit dwellings, and does not require any change in land use permitted under the New York City Zoning Resolution;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Project on August 15, 2005;

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use and financial implications and other policy issues relating to the Project;


#### RESOLVED:

The Council finds that the present status of the Project Area tends to impair or arrest the sound growth and development of the City of New York and that a designation of the Project as an urban development action area project is consistent with the policy and purposes stated in Section 691 of the General Municipal Law.

The Council waives the area designation requirement pursuant to Section 693 of the General Municipal Law.

The Council waives the requirements of Sections 197-c and 197-d of the New York City Charter pursuant to Section 694 of the General Municipal Law.

The Council approves the Project as an urban development action area project pursuant to Section 694 of the General Municipal Law.
