WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on July 6, 2005 a copy of its designation dated June 28, 2005 (the "Designation"), of The Windermere located at 400-406 West 57th Street, aka 869 Ninth Avenue and 871-877 Ninth Avenue, Community District 4, Borough of Manhattan, as a historic landmark and Block 1066, Lot 32, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter:

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on August 29, 2005, its report on the Designation dated August 24, 2005 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on September 26, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;
