WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on September 9, 2005 its approval of the petition dated September 8, 2005 of Paleros, Inc., (the "Applicant"), for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 37-01 30th Avenue, Community District 1, Borough of Queens, (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
