(the "Applicant"), for a revocable consent to continue to maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 113 Seventh Avenue South, Community District 2, Borough of Manhattan, (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
