Section one. Rule 7.50 of the Rules of the Council shall read as follows:

7.50 Meetings.- d. Committees shall provide reasonable advance notice at least seventy-two hours where practical of committee meetings to the public. Such notice shall be given to the news media and shall be posted in a public location at City Hall and the web site.
