**Whereas**, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by the Senate Committee on Rules, S.5628-A, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.6512-A, "AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to allowing members of the police pension fund to obtain retirement credit for certain periods of New York police cadet corps service"; and
