State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Duane, S.7370, and Assembly Member O'Donnell, A.10506, "AN ACT to correct the status of the membership of Ronald J. Schmidt in the New York city employees' retirement system".

**Whereas**, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Duane, S.7370, and Assembly Member O'Donnell, A.10506, "AN ACT to correct the status of the membership of Ronald J. Schmidt in the New York city employees' retirement system"; and

**Whereas**, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it

**Resolved**, that the Council of the City of New York, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of Article 9 of the Constitution of the State of New York, does hereby request the New York State Legislature to enact into law the aforesaid pending bills.
