WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on May 24, 2006 a copy of its designation dated May 16, 2006 (the "Designation"), of The Estey Piano Company Factory, located at 112-128 Lincoln Avenue (aka 15-19 Bruckner Boulevard and 270-278 East 134th Street), Community District 1, Borough of the Bronx, as a landmark and Block 2309, Lot 1, in part, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on July 14, 2006, its report on the Designation dated July 12, 2006 (the "Report");
