WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on June 30, 2006 a copy of its designation dated June 20, 2006 (the "Designation"), of Astoria Park Pool and Play Center located at 24-02 to 24-36 19th Street, Community District 1, Borough of Queens, as a landmark and Block 898, Lot 1, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on August 11, 2006, its report on the Designation dated August 9, 2006 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on September 7, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

RESOLVED:
